It will provide an opportunity for attendees to learn from leading palliative care researchers and clinicians, meet with potential research collaborators and find out how you can apply for funding with the National Institute for Health and Care Research. We are delighted to now invite **abstract submissions** to present a poster at this conference, which aims to build capacity for palliative and end-of-life care research across the island of Ireland. We particularly encourage submissions from individuals in the early stages of their careers.

Abstracts should be no more than 300 words, be written in English, and contain no references, tables, or figures. Submissions should include the following sections: background (including context and aim); methods; findings; and interpretation.
